Holidays: Please call the landfill staff or check the landfill answering machine message for holiday hours.

Large Item Pickup: Please call the Selectman's Office at (860) 668-3838 to schedule. A \$40 pickup fee will be charged for this service. The additional fees listed below are also applicable.

Trash & Recycling Area: A Town of Suffield Trash Area Add-On permit is available for \$20 at the landfill and is valid from July 1 to July 1 (non-prorated). This permit allows residents with curbside trash service to bring extra household trash to the landfill. Extra recyclables (newspaper, cardboard, bottles & cans, etc.) may be brought to the landfill for free.

Electronics Recycling: Free of charge for residential electronic items. Business or commercially generated electronics will NOT be accepted.

Bulky Waste Area: No sticker is required, but residents must show proof of residency.

The following fees apply to all areas of the landfill:

Freon Units: <i>refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water coolers</i>	\$15 per item
Mattresses/ Bedding: <i>mattresses (including futon and sleeper sofa)</i>	\$20 each piece
Stuffed Furniture: <i>couches, loveseats, hot tub covers</i>	\$20 each piece
<i>stuffed chairs</i>	\$10 each piece
Oversized Plastic/ Fiberglass: <i>hot tubs, boats, etc. (cut up with metal removed)</i>	\$80 per ton
Propane Tanks: <i>20 pound (gas grill size)</i>	\$2 per tank
Tires: <i>car (up to 15")</i>	\$2 per tire
<i>car / light truck / slicks (15" – 20")</i>	\$5 per tire
<i>heavy truck (17" – 20")</i>	\$15 per tire
<i>construction equipment (over 20")</i>	\$50 – \$100 per tire
<i>Non-commercial batteries, motor oil and antifreeze (in separate 1 to 5 gallon containers) are free of charge.</i>	

Residents who deliver bulky waste to the landfill in a vehicle up to and including $\frac{3}{4}$ ton capacity, are NOT required to go over the scale. However, any residents using larger vehicles (over $\frac{3}{4}$ ton) and dual axle trailers must go over the scale at a rate of \$80 per ton (no minimum) for all material.

Business and commercial bulky waste from Suffield properties only, is accepted at the landfill. All business and commercial vehicles must go over the scale at a rate of \$80 per ton. Proof of origin of material and/ or a building permit is required. Business or commercially generated trash will NOT be accepted.

All loads are subject to inspection.
