

CERTIFICATE OF REFERENDUM VOTE

We, Kathy Dunai, Town Clerk of Suffield, Connecticut, and Cathy McKeen, Moderator of the referendum held in the Town of Suffield, Connecticut on October 8, 2015, hereby certify that a referendum vote of the electors and citizens qualified to vote in Town Meetings of said Town was held in said Town on October 8, 2015 between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M.; that the questions submitted to referendum vote were placed on the [paper ballots] voting machines under the following heading and that the results of said referendum vote was as follows:

“SHALL THE TOWN OF SUFFIELD APPROPRIATE \$9,100,000 FOR ROAD AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF BONDS, NOTES OR TEMPORARY NOTES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$9,100,000 TO FINANCE SAID APPROPRIATION?”

Number of “No” votes 784




